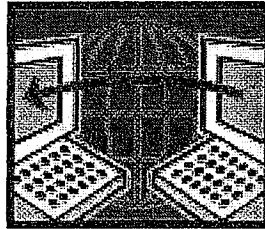
## Email Notification a Success
